THE general run of this puzzle is not difficult but there are a few unexpected words that will trip your pencil. For example, who knows that straw saddle, and those unhewn stone monuments?

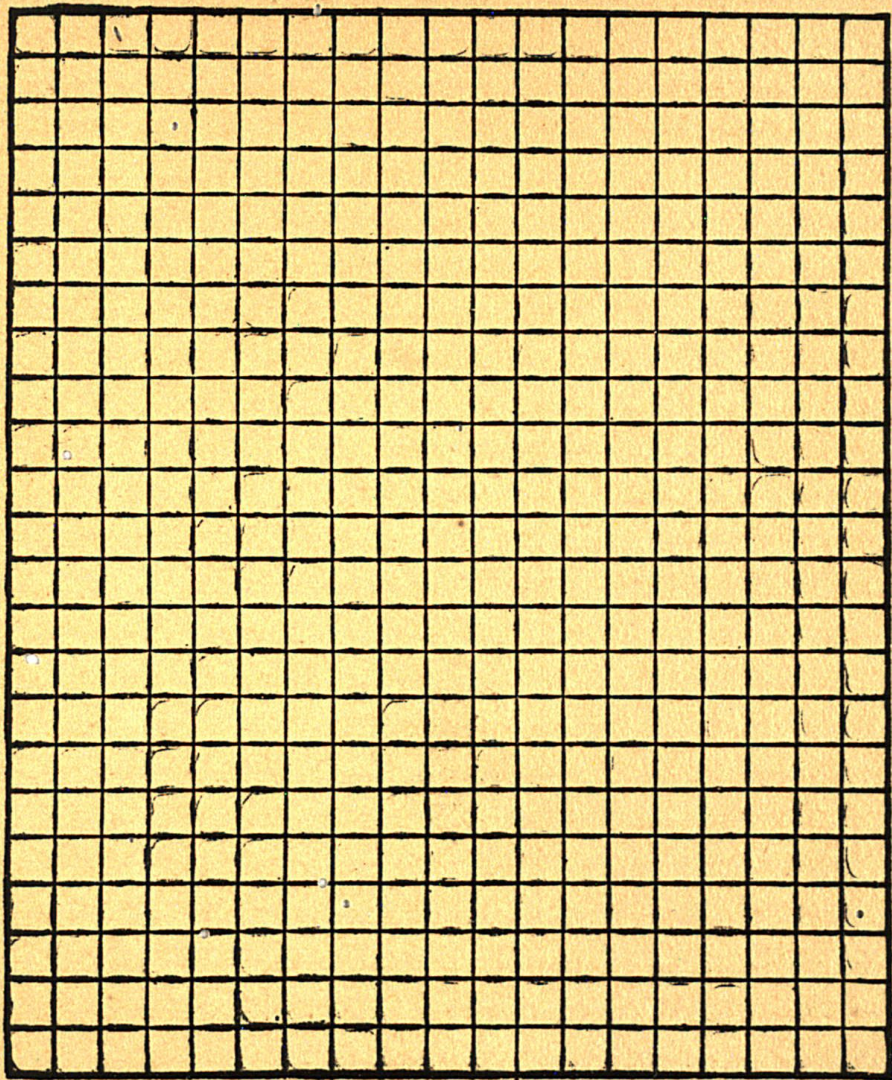

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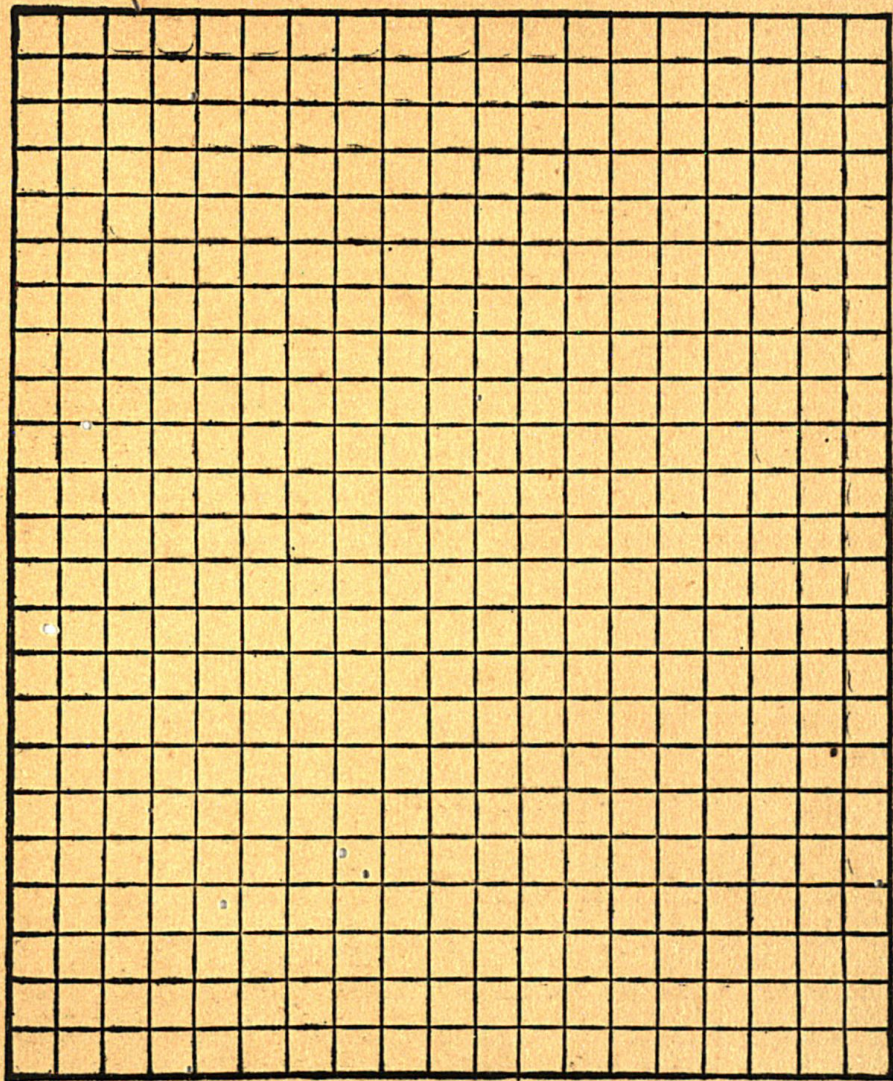
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A MANY-SIDED PATTERN

THE numbering ought to give you your first clue to the pattern concealed here. Watch your outline like a hawk and you'll come out all right.

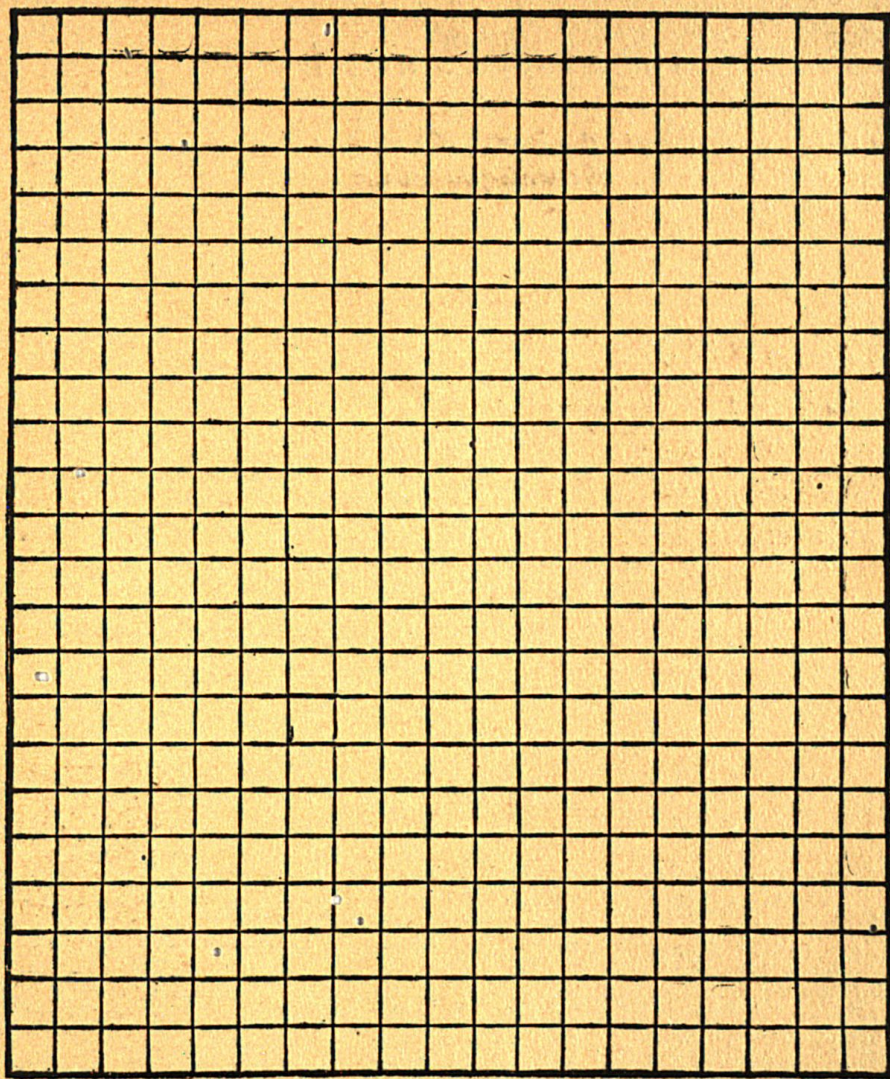
